After arguing at length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw this petition with liberty to surrender before the trial Court and to move an application for grant of regular bail.

In view of the aforesaid submission, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn. In case, the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within 10 days from today and moves an application for grant of regular bail, the trial Court shall endeavour to dispose of the same expeditiously, preferably within a period of one week from filing of such application.

The trial Court while deciding the application shall take into account the fact that the petitioner is attributed an injury on non-vital part only.
