Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to procure and preserve CCTV footage of the place of occurrence/incident, which took place between 23.05.2022 to 27.05.2022 at office of respondent No.4, visitor register for the concerned period and tower location of the mobile phone of the husband of the petitioner i.e. 8800960383 for the said period, in case file No.GEXCOM/AE/VRFN/77/2022-AE-O/OCOMMR-CGST-

Gurugram titled as 'CGST, Gurugram Vs. Suni Mahalawat and others' registered under Sections 132(1)(i) read with Section 132(1)(c)(e)(f) CGST Act, 2017.

On 06.06.2022, a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court was pleased to pass the following order: -
