Present application has been filed for placing on record speaking order dated 12.03.2021 as Annexure R5/1.

Keeping in view the averments made in the application, the same is allowed and order dated 12.03.2021 as Annexure R5/1 is taken on record.

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In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is non-release of the pensionary benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that in the present case, during the pendency of the petition, the respondents have already

released the pensionary benefits for which the petitioner is entitled for and the only grievance to be redressed is for the grant of interest on the delay release of the pensionary benefits keeping in view the judgment of Full Bench of this Court in *A.S. Randhawa Vs. State of Punjab and others*, 1997(3) SCT 468 and hence, petitioner be given liberty to approach the respondents by filing appropriate representation seeking the relief of interest.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that in case, the petitioner submits any representation raising any grievance, the same will be looked into in accordance with law and appropriate order on the same will be passed within a period of eight weeks and in case, after the decision, if the petitioner is found entitled for any monetary benefit, the same will also be released to him within a period of next four weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the above, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.

Ordered accordingly.
