Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of an appropriate direction to official respondents No.2 and 3 to take immediate action and register a case under relevant provisions against private respondents No.4 to 8. Another prayer has been made that respondent No.2 be directed to decide representation dated 27.04.2022 (Annexure P-1).

Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner was married to respondent No.4 on 30.06.2019. However, despite the fact that sufficient dowry was given at the time of marriage, but neither her husband nor his relatives were satisfied with the same. It has been submitted that the petitioner is being harassed and maltreated at their hands. Counsel submits that the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 27.04.2022

(Annexure P-1) to Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, which has not been attended to.

Notice of motion restricted to respondents No.1 to 3 only, at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Amandeep Singh Gill, Sr. DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf behalf.

Having heard counsel for the parties, but without examining the allegations levelled in the petition or in the representation, petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to examine the representation and to take suitable action thereon, as warranted in accordance with law.
