Prayer in this writ petition is for direction to respondent no.2 to regularize petitioner's suspension period from 23.11.2010 to 01.12.2011 as duty period. There is a further prayer to release full salary of the suspension period with interest at the rate of 18% per annum as no case was made out against the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondents has furnished copy of order dated 20.05.2022, Annexure R-1, passed by the Directorate of Elementary Education Haryana, Shiksha Sadan, Sector-5, Panchkula, wherein the petitioner has been found guilty of misconduct, insubordination and violation of Conduct Rules. Punishment of stoppage of one increment with cumulative effect has been imposed. Period of suspension up to 90 days is directed to be treated as duty period and period of suspension of more than 90 days till re-instatement of the delinquent has been directed to be treated as leave of kind due.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in view of order dated 20.05.2022, this writ petition is rendered infructuous. Copy of

order dated 20.05.2022, furnished in Court today, is taken on record subject to just exceptions.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is unable to deny the same.

Writ petition is accordingly disposed of as infructuous.

Needless to say, petitioner is at liberty to challenge order dated 20.05.2022 in accordance with law, if so, advised.
