This is a petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 to 4 to arrest the accused person namely Deepak son of Rakesh Kumar in FIR No.333 dated 26.12.2021 registered under Sections 147, 149, 323, 302, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Chhapar, Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

On 09.08.2022, a Coordinate Bench of this Court, after considering that the reply filed on behalf of the State was self-contradictory, had directed the Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar to be present in person.

In pursuance of the said order, Mr. Mohit Handa, Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar is present in person.

Learned State Counsel has submitted that the accused-Deepak son of Rakesh Kumar has been arrested in the present case and even supplementary challan qua Deepak has also been presented in the Court. It is further submitted that earlier, the co-accused of the said Deepak namely Aakash Singh had already been arrested and challan qua him had also been presented in the Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the abovesaid circumstances, the petitioner is satisfied and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
