Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the pension of the petitioner was wrongly fixed by the respondents after revision of pay scale, which came into effect from 1.1.2006. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the pension of the petitioner was fixed by the respondents @ Rs.6393/- instead of Rs.8995/- therefore, the respondents are liable to be directed to grant the petitioner pay for which, he is legally entitled for.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of submitting a representation dated 17.01.2022 (Annexure P/2), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied in case a time bound direction be issued to the respondent No.2 to decide the said representation.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Navdeep Chhabra, DAG,

Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 17.01.2022 (Annexure P/2) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in his representation, respondent No.2 is directed to decide the representation dated 17.01.2022 (Annexure P/2) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order. In case after the decision it is found that petitioner is entitled for any benefit, the same will be extended to him within a period of next four weeks.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
