AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition is filed in the nature of Habeas Corpus for release of detenue-Simran Kaur who has been allegedly illegally detained by respondents No. 4 and 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner fairly submits that detenue along with an other filed a petition seeking protection as they were in live-in relationship. That petition was disposed of on 19.1.2022 directing the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur to consider the representation made by the petitioners.

From the pleadings and the contention raised by learned counsel for the petitioner, it is evident that the detenue has now attained majority. She had approached this Court in January, 2022 seeking protection as she was in live-in relationship meaning thereby the petitioner is not in illegal custody of respondent No. 4.

No further directions are called for. Petition is disposed of.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.
