The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
for quashing of FIR No.143 dated 05.05.2015, under Sections
420/469/471/384/182 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines,
Amritsar City.

Notice of motion in the present case was issued on
16.02.2016.

Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel appearing
for respondent No.2 have submitted that in the present case, the charges
have been framed and thereafter, three witnesses have also been
examined.

Learned State counsel has produced on record the copy of

order dated 12.07.2022 passed by the trial Court to show that three witnesses have already been examined and the fourth witness was bound down for the next date. The copy of the said order is taken on record and has been marked as "Mark A'.

None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to controvert the said fact.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to raise all the pleas as raised in the present petition before the trial Court as the trial has made sufficient progress.

However, it is made clear that in case, any cause survives, it would be open to the petitioner to file a fresh petition, in accordance with law.

Pending miscellaneous application, if any, stands disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
