This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of Certiorari calling for the records of the Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court, Panipat and set aside the impugned award dated 09.09.2021 (Annexure P-3); with certain other prayers made in the present petition.

A perusal of the petition itself shows that the petitioner has himself asserted that he has worked with the respondent No.2 from 24.05.2016 to 09.09.2016. Therefore, by any means, he has not completed 240 days of service as required under the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 for protection of any kind.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any illegality or perversity with the award passed by the Labour Court. Therefore, the present petition is dismissed.
