The petitioner is a competitor of respondent No. 6 in whose favour letter of intent has been issued by respondent No. 4 based upon which NOCs have been granted by the District authorities. In order dated 02.03.2022 passed in CWP No. 3322 of 2022 titled as *Shri Ram Filling Station vs. Union of India and others*, I have already held that a competitor has no *locus standi* in such matters.

Thus, the writ petition is dismissed on the ground that the petitioner does not possess *locus standi* to maintain the writ petition.
