The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.180 dated 26.10.2021 registered under Sections 307, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 3(2)(v) of the Schedule Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and Section 302 of the IPC added later on) at Police Station Sadar Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance with order dated 25.08.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation and the matter has also been compromised between the parties.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Ramesh Kumar, submits that in pursuance of order dated 25.08.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer

required for custodial interrogation.

Learned counsel for the complainant also admits the factum of compromise.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 25.08.2022 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
