This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to the official respondents No.1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his wife and not to harass them at the behest of private respondents and direct the official respondents not to implicate the petitioner and his wife in any false case.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioner has moved a representation dated 23.12.2021 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.2.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3- State only.

On asking of this Court, Ms. Sakshi Bakshi, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with directions to respondent No. 2 i.e. the Senior Superintendent of Police, Nawanshahr, SBS Nagar to decide the representation (Annexure P-4) of the petitioner as per law within a period of one month from today.
