The petitioner herein has sought the relief of anticipatory bail in the criminal case arisen out of the FIR bearing No.27 dated 07.05.2022 registered at Police Station Singh Bhagwantpur District Rupnagar, under Sections 323, 324, 326, 341, 148 and 149 IPC.

2. Today, learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Subhash Chander from the afore-said Police Station, apprises the Court that in compliance of the order dated 02.06.2022 as passed by the Co-ordinate Bench, the petitioner has joined in the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required and he is also not involved in any other criminal case of the similar nature.

3. In view of the above-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, the instant petition is allowed and the relief of interim bail, as extended to the petitioner by the Co-ordinate Bench vide the said order dated

02.06.2022, is hereby made absolute.

4. However, the petitioner shall continue to join in the investigation as and when required/called upon to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
