Prayer in this petition is for setting aside the order dated 23.01.2020 passed by the trial Court, vide which the petitioner was declared a proclaimed person in Criminal Complaint bearing NACT No.9669 dated 12.08.2016, titled as Universal Management Vs. Deepak Taneja.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the order declaring the petitioner as proclaimed person was passed without following the proper procedure, however, he has instructions to say that the petitioner will surrender before the trial Court within a period of 30 days from today and will hand over a demand draft of 20% of the cheque amount to

respondent No.2-complainant.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, issuance of notice of motion to the respondents is dispensed with in order to avoid further delay in disposal of the trial and this petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court within a period of 30 days from today and he will be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate.

This will, however, be subject to the condition that while furnishing bail/surety bonds, the petitioner will hand over a demand draft of 20% of the cheque amount to respondent No.2-complainant.

Disposed of, accordingly.
