Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.99 dated 28.12.2016 registered under Sections 22, 61, 85 of NDPS Act at Police Station Jodhan, District Ludhiana Rural.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of previous order of interim bail, the petitioner joined the proceedings before the trial Court. State counsel on instructions from ASI Baljeet Singh has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by the counsel for the petitioner.

In the present case, the petitioner was granted regular bail by the learned trial Court vide order dated 30.1.2017 (Annexure P-2) and thereafter, he jumped bail on 29.3.2022 and apprehending his arrest, the petitioner filed the present petition and now he has joined the proceedings before the trial Court.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 2.6.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
