Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.110 dated 04.09.2020 under Sections 326, 323, 506, 148, and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Bhindi Saidon, District Amritsar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 02.06.2022 passed by this Court, petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioners have joined investigation in terms of orders dated 02.06.2022 and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 02.06.2022 is made absolute.
