This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for quashing of FIR No.67 dated 01.04.2019, under Sections 323, 324, 379, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 326 IPC has been added later on), registered at Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

On 31.07.2019, none had put in appearance on behalf of the parties. Today also, no one has appeared on behalf of the petitioners and respondent No.2. It seems that the compromise has not fortified between the parties and they are not ready to give their statements, thus, the present petition is dismissed. However, the liberty is granted to the parties to file a fresh petition in case the compromise still subsists and the parties are ready to give their statements before the trial Court.
