2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that vide order Annexure P/1 dated 09.03.2021, in CWP-5538-2021, CWP-5541-2021, CWP-5517-2021 and CWP-5554-2021 filed by the petitioner(s), were disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to decide the claim of the petitioner(s) as contained in legal notice dated 03.02.2021 as served by them and that pursuant to issuance of notice in the instant petitions, respondent No.3 released payment on account of principal amount to all the petitioners though belatedly and that in the circumstances, the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant petitions and the same may be disposed of as such, while granting liberty to the petitioner(s) to seek interest on the belated payment of principal amount, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

3. The same is not opposed to by the learned counsel for respondent No.3.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner(s), the instant petitions are *disposed of* as not calling for any action against respondent Nos.3 and 4, under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner(s) as prayed for.
