[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexures P-1 & P-2, dated 13.11.2017 and 23.08.2018, in CWP No.25682 of 2014 and LPA No.475 of 2018 in case titled as '**Arun Singh and others**versus**State of Haryana and another**& '**Haryana School Teachers Selection Board**versus**Sudha and others**' respectively.

[2] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of order dated 24.12.2020 passed by the Secretary, Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula, Haryana, of the petitioner having no right vested for appointment against unfilled posts on account of failure of the selection candidates to join, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 24.12.2020, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

[3] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of

learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
