The petitioners are seeking to quash the FIR No. 83 dated 06.04.2018 under Sections 323/324/376-D/506/120-B IPC read with Sections 3 and 4 of POSCO Act (later on offence under Section 346 IPC deleted), registered at Police Station Jamalpur, District Ludhiana, on the basis of compromise.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Kamaljeet Singh, has pointed out that in terms of the judgment dated 01.03.2019, the petitioners have been acquitted by the trial Court and the present petition has become infructuous.

In view of the categoric assertion made by learned State counsel, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

However, none has appeared on behalf of the petitioners. They shall be at liberty to move an application for revival of the petition within a period of three months, if the aforesaid assertion of learned State counsel is found to be factually incorrect.
