Instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking grant of regular bail in FIR No.51 dated 15.04.2021, registered for offences under Sections 354 and 452 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 10 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, at Police Station Women Jind, District Jind, Annexure P-1.

Upon instructions, L/SI, Premwati, State counsel submits that the departmental proceedings initiated against L/SI, Prem Kumari, who was the Investigating Officer, have culminated and she has been found to be guilty in the enquiry conducted by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, District Jind. She submits that further action is being taken in the matter.

Mr. Lekh Raj Sharma, Advocate has filed an affidavit dated 27.10.2022 of Mr. Virender Singh Bhankhur, Advocate, who is present in person. Affidavit is taken on record.

Perusal of the affidavit shows that the counsel has admitted his mistake and has tendered an unconditional and unqualified apology, which is accepted by this Court.

In view of the above, this Court deems it proper to drop the proceedings against Mr. Virender Singh Bhankhur, Advocate.

State counsel submits that trial has concluded and the accused has been acquitted vide judgment dated 04.10.2022 and the present petition has become infructuous.

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
