The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing the respondents to transfer the investigation of the complaint moved by the petitioner from Civil Surgeon Moga to any other appropriate authority and a further prayer to direct the respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 13.07.2021.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the respondents in their statement have already said that they have formulated a Committee for examining the complaints submitted by the petitioner. She contends that the instant petition had been filed against Dr. Raminder Sharma (against whom the complaint was moved) who was previously serving as Medical Officer in Civil Hospital, Moga. Hence, the petitioner apprehended a bias. It is contended that since Board of Doctors has already been constituted.

She seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition in case she has any subsisting cause of action against the constituent members of the Board of Doctors, if any, if so advised.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
