This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing FIR No.120, dated 21.10.1999, under Sections 325, 323 and 34 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Bholath, District Kapurthala and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of the compromise dated 08.12.2017 (Annexure P-3).
