The prayer under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.210 dated 15.04.2022 under Sections 147, 149, 323, 452, 365, 506 IPC registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Sirsa, Haryana, District Sirsa.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 02.06.2022 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel has filed Status report by way of affidavit of Mr. Sadhu Ram, DSP Sirsa on behalf of the State and on instructions from SI Lekh Raj submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 02.06.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 02.06.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
