Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of impugned order dated 31.08.2018, Annexure P-4, passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Faridkot, vide which the revision petition filed by the petitioner has been dismissed and the impugned order dated 07.09.2015, Annexure P-3, passed by learned Principal Magistrate Juvenile Justice Board, Faridkot, vide which the petitioner has been declared as major in case bearing FIR No.34 dated 05.06.2012, Annexure P-1, registered for offences under Sections 363, 366-A and 376 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Sadiq, District Faridkot. Further prayer has been made that proceedings before the Trial Court may be stayed during the pendency of the present petition.

Upon instructions received from ASI, Gurcharan Singh, State counsel submits that the accused has been acquitted vide judgment dated 28.01.2022 by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Faridkot. He submits that the petition has accordingly become infructuous.
