Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.0010 dated 09.02.2022 under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Haryana, District Hoshiarpur, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in terms of the order dated 02.06.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for further custodial interrogation/investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from concerned official has affirmed the above factual position and states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and as such, he is no longer required for custodial interrogation/investigation.

In view of the above stand taken by the learned State counsel, the order dated 02.06.2022 passed by this Court granting interim relief to the petition is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
