[1] Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

[2] Prayer in the petition under Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Section 10 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order (Annexure P-1) dated 30.09.2020 in CWP-PIL No.133 of 2020 in case titled as 'Hari Kishan versus State of Haryana and others'.

[3] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that the writ petition was disposed of with a direction to the respondents to take a decision on the complaints filed by the petitioner after hearing all the parties concerned and thereafter to pass a reasoned order to be communicated to the petitioner, as also to take necessary steps in accordance with law, if so required.

[4] Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the respondents has passed order dated 24.09.2021, deciding the complaints

filed by the petitioner in compliance of order dated 30.09.2020 in CWP-PIL No.133 of 2020.

[5] Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the position noted above, he does not press the instant petition and the same may be disposed of as such.

[6] I have considered the submissions of learned counsel.

[7] Admittedly, order dated 24.09.2021 has been passed by the respondents in compliance of order dated 30.09.2020 in CWP-PIL No.133 of 2020.

[8] Accordingly, in the light of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, no action is called for against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

[9] Contempt petition is *disposed of*, accordingly.
