Today, at the very outset, the learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to raise all the pleas as have been raised herein before the trial Court at appropriate stage, including his plea to the effect that petitioners who are merely agents and used to refer clients were not supposed to conduct any verification as regards ownership, documents, title etc. and that the requisite verification had been got done by the LIC through three different professional agents.
