Perusal of file shows that this matter was already decided vide order dated 25.07.2022 by this Lok Adalat. The respondent-Insurance Company was directed to deposit crossed-cheque for ₹2,00,000/- in the name of appellant-Basant Kaur widow of Shri Mukhtiar Singh. In compliance of the said order, the respondent-Insurance Company had also deposited crossed-cheque for ₹2,00,000/- in favour of Smt.Basant Kaur. However, the cheque deposited could not be taken by learned counsel for the appellant as only appellant, Smt.Basant Kaur, had already expired. He moved an application for bringing on record L.Rs of deceased-Basant Kaur before the Hon'ble High Court. The said application was decided by the Hon'ble High Court vide order dated 30.09.2022. Fresh Memo of Parties was also filed.

In view of the same, the original cheque, which was already deposited by the respondent-Insurance Company in favour of Basant Kaur, has been returned today itself to learned counsel and representatives of the

Insurance Company.

The respondent-Insurance Company has been further directed to issue fresh crossed-cheques in the same amount in the respective names of all the six L.Rs of deceased-Basant Kaur, in equal shares, with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of four weeks, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipts after receiving the cheques to learned counsel/representative of the respondent- Insurance Company. The appellant(s)'counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheques from the office of the Lok Adalat.

The matter stands disposed of.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
