Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 110 dated 21.07.2018, registered under Sections 21 and 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Islamabad, Police Commissionerate, Amritsar.

The petitioner was granted the concession of interim bail awaiting the FSL, however, after the receipt of the FSL report, the petitioner has not surrendered back as per terms and conditions of the said order.

A perusal of the FIR would show that recovery is of commercial quantity.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner limits his prayer and submits that petitioner may be granted liberty to surrender before the trial Court and the trial Court may be directed that if the petitioner moves an application for grant of regular bail, the same be decided expeditiously.

In view of the above limited prayer of the petitioner, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court that in case the

petitioner surrenders before it within a period of seven days from today and moves an application for grant of regular bail, the same shall be decided within a period of seven days thereafter.
