

BHARAT CHEMICAL HOUSE V/S UNION OF INDIA AND ORS.

The present petition has been filed by the petitioner for issuance of direction to the concerned Court to decide Execution No.60 of 2018 (Annexure P-3) in a time bound manner.

However, the perusal of the zimini orders placed on record reveals that execution was in fact, filed on 22.02.2018 and since then, it remained pending for the issuance of notice to the JDs, which was completed on 26.09.2019. Thereafter, reply was filed and execution remained pending for consideration.

However, we should not lose sight of the fact that on account of pandemic, all the Courts have been working under constrained circumstances. Considering the same, no case is made out for giving any time bound direction to decide the execution. But, anyhow, learned Executing Court is hereby requested to consider the feasibility of expeditious disposal of the execution in hand.

Accordingly, the present petition is hereby dismissed.
