On 29.07.2021, this Court passed the following order:-

“This is a petition that has been filed for seeking a direction to the Appellate Court to conclude the appeal filed by the petitioner titled as Gurmeet Kaur vs. Harsimranjit Singh and another bearing CRA No. 297 of 2019.

At this stage, a request is made for an adjournment by the proxy counsel appearing on behalf of Mr. K. P. Singh, Advocate for the petitioner.

Normally such a request would have been accepted, however, it has been experienced by this Court that Mr. K.P. Singh, Advocate has filed several matters seeking similar prayers and has not been putting in any appearance in any one of them. In fact, this Court has even dismissed one such

petition earlier.

The matter is adjourned to 02.12.2021,however, subject to payment of Rs.1,000/- as costs to be deposited in the Poor Patients Welfare Fund, PGIMER, Chandigarh within a month.”

Despite opportunity, costs has not been deposited.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not have any instructions.

It seems that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the petition.

Accordingly, petition is ordered to be dismissed for non-prosecution.
