This petition was filed for setting aside the impugned order dated 25.10.2018 in case of FIR No. 5 dated 23.3.2007 under Sections 409, 420, 468, 471, 120-B IPC (Section 201 IPC added later on) and Section 7, 13 (1) (C) (D) read with Section 13 (2) and 14 of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 registered at P.S. Vigilance Bureau, Ludhiana was rejected.
