The Civil Misc. Application No.6130-CII as filed by the applicant-appellant for seeking condonation of the delay of 573 days in filing the appeal bearing FAO No.1580 of 2005, CM No.6131-CII of 2005 as moved by him with a prayer to exempt him from depositing 1/4th amount of compensation for filing the said appeal and CM No.6132-CII of 2005 as preferred by him for seeking the stay of the execution of the impugned Award dated 19.05.2003, have been listed today in pursuance of the order dated 21.09.2022 annexed at 'A' herewith and the said appeal has been included in 'Table-E' as prepared by the concerned Branch to categorise the cases wherein the statutory amount has not been deposited.

A perusal of the file reveals that on 01.04.2005, learned counsel for the appellant had sought an adjournment to deposit the

statutory amount and vide the order as passed on that day, this Court had directed for listing the appeal as and when the needful was done in this regard and as reflected in the relevant column in 'Table-E' itself, the said statutory amount has not yet been deposited.

Learned counsel for the applicant-appellant also submits that during the *inter-regnum*, the appellant has never ever approached him for depositing the said amount.

In view of the above-discussed facts and circumstances, it seems that the appellant is not interested in pursuing the instant appeal any more.

Resultantly, the appeal, along-with all the afore-described Civil Miscellaneous applications in hand, stands dismissed accordingly.
