Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 not to harass the petitioners at the instance of respondent No.4, as they are living together in live-in-relationship

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1–Ravandeep Kaur, aged 20 years and petitioner No.2–Gursimran Singh, aged 19 years, are living together in live-in-relationship against the wishes of their family members. It has further been submitted that the private respondent No.4, who is father of petitioner No.1, is threatening to interfere in the life of the petitioners. Hence, they have approached respondent No.2 by filing representation dated 31.05.2022 (Annexure P-3) seeking protection in that regard and have also approached this Court by way of filing the instant petition.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of Court, Mr. Luvinder Sofat, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

5. On a pointed query put to the learned counsel as to whether any FIR stood registered against petitioner No.2 with regard to missing of petitioner No.1, he has replied in the negative.

6. In view of the above, the petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur to look into the representation dated 31.05.2022 (Annexure P-3) at the earliest and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law, to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioners is not jeopardized at the hands of private respondent. However, this direction will have no effect on any civil or criminal action, which could be initiated in the matter in accordance with law.
