1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 16.11.2021 in CWP-1288-2020.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 16.11.2021 reveals that CWP-1288-2020 was disposed of by directing the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner for premature release without taking into account the jail offence committed by him and pass necessary orders within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order failing which the petitioner be released on parole on his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of the concerned District Magistrate.

3. Reply has been filed alongwith copy of order dated 15.07.2022 releasing the petitioner on parole pending decision on the request of the petitioner for premature release.

4. The aforementioned reply is taken on record. Copy thereof

has already been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on instructions states that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same

5. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
