This is the first petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.38 dated 27.11.2020, under Sections 420, 120-B IPC and Sections 66, 66(c) and 66(d) of the Information Technology Act, registered at Police Station Punjab State Cyber Crime, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner in the present case without admitting his liability is ready to pay an amount of Rs.1,50,000/- to the complainant and states that he be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a second petition for anticipatory bail after preparing a demand draft of an amount of Rs.1,50,000/- in the name of complainant Gursharanjit Singh.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty to the petitioner to file a second petition for anticipatory bail after preparing a demand draft of an amount of Rs.1,50,000/- in the name of complainant Gursharanjit Singh.
