The hearing of the case is being held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

The petitioner has invoked the inherent jurisdiction of the High Court under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuing directions to the respondents to register an FIR. The petitioner alleges that when he was walking near his house, certain accused came in a car and fired at him. He claims that despite a complaint made to the Police, in this regard, no FIR has been registered.

After having heard the learned counsel representing the petitioner at some length, this Court is of the considered opinion that the petitioner, in the facts of the present case, has a remedy of filing a criminal complaint before the concerned Judicial Magistrate. Hence, the petitioner is relegated to the alternative remedy.

With these observations, the present petition is disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
