The petitioner herein seeks the quashing of the FIR bearing No.63 dated 24.03.2013 registered at Police Station Matur, District S.A.S. Nagar, under Sections 212, 216, 467, 468, 471 & 120-B IPC as well as all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Mr. Sandeep Singh Deol, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, has appeared on behalf of all the respondents in this case in pursuance of the copies of the instant petition having been sent to the respondent-State in advance and on the instructions from SI Narender Kumar from the above-said Police Station, he apprises the Court that the cancellation report in respect of the subject FIR has already been submitted before the competent Court.
