The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.0050 dated 16.07.2018 registered under Sections 307, 323, 148, 149, 1860 and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Khem Karan, District Tarn Taran.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 19.07.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A short reply dated 17.11.2022 has been filed on behalf of respondent-State by the learned State counsel by way of an affidavit of Preetinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Valtaha Camp at Bhikhiwind, District Tarn Taran and the same is taken on record. He submits that on instructions from ASI Baljinder Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 17.11.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on

joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
