[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 28.03.2022 in CRM-M No.12871 of 2022 in case titled as Deepak Kumar vs. State of Punjab and Ors.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CRM-M No.12871 of 2022 was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide representation dated 23.02.2022 submitted by the petitioner in accordance with law within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Reply along with speaking order, Annexure R/1 dated 28.05.2022, partly accepting the claim made in the representation dated 23.02.2022 of the petitioner, is already on record.

[4] Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant

challenge order, Annexure R/1 dated 28.05.2022 to the extent the same is against the petitioner.

[5] In the light of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
