Prayer in the present petition is for quashing of the FIR No.44 dated 20.09.2016, registered under Section 498-A IPC, at Police Station Women, Amritsar, and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of the compromise dated 06.09.2018 (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has submitted that respondent No.2-complainant is not agreed with the compromise arrived at between the parties. He has submitted that the petitioner has not fulfilled the terms and conditions of the compromise and thereafter, respondent No.2-complainant is not ready to compromise the matter and thus, wants to pursue the case on merits.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the parties to pursue their remedy as available to them in accordance with law.
