The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C praying for quashing of FIR No.163 dated 22.7.2019 under sections 498-A, 494, 323, 34 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Canal Colony, Bathinda along all consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise dated 1.7.2021 (Annexure P-5).

Apparently the petitioners have filed two petitions for quashing of the same FIR; one on the basis of compromise and the another on merits.

Having argued the matter at some length, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to avail alternate remedies as available to the petitioners in accordance with law including pursuing the other petition filed for quashing on merits.

Prayer is allowed.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty, as prayed for.
