Writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for directing the respondent(s) to release the service benefits which includes suspension allowance from 17.09.2012 to 26.09.2013; Dearness Allowance and Annual Increments along with arrears; and interest on the delay payments.

Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that instead of pressing the writ petition on merits at this stage, his client would be satisfied in case, legal notice dated 06.05.2022 (P-1) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to that limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Anu Chatrath, Addl.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Learned State counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the

petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without adjudicating the controversy on merits, writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.1-Principal Secretary, Department of Health and Family Welfare, Punjab, to consider and decide the aforesaid legal notice dated 06.05.2022 (P-1), by passing a reasoned order in accordance with law, within a period of 04 (four) months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to say that in case there is a failure on the part of competent authority, petitioner would be at liberty to move an appropriate application for revival of this writ petition.
