The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.225 dated 13.08.2019, registered under Sections 279, 379 IPC, at Police Station North Chandigarh, Chandigarh, and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 16.07.2020 (Annexure P-2).

Vide order dated 24.08.2020, the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court was directed to record the statements of all concerned parties with regard to the genuineness and validity or otherwise of the compromise.

At this stage, learned State counsel, points out that subsequently while presenting the challan on 28.07.2021, Section 338 IPC and Section 3/181 of the Motor Vehicle Act, have been added.
