[1] Application is for permission to place on record copy of speaking order, Annexure CM/1 dated 29.07.2022 passed by respondent No.3 as well as to withdraw the contempt petition in view thereof.

[2] The contempt petition is listed for hearing on 01.12.2022. However, on oral request of learned counsel for the petitioner, the same is preponed from 01.12.2022 to today and is taken on board for hearing today itself.

[3] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure CP/1 dated 03.05.2021 in CWP No.9377 of 2021 in case titled as Gurjit Singh Bhathal vs. Union of India and Ors.

[4] A perusal of order, Annexure CP/1 reveals that CWP No.9377 of 2021 was disposed of by directing the official respondents to

consider and decide representations dated 28.08.2012, 27.04.2015, 26.02.2020 and 21.09.2020 respectively moved by the petitioner in accordance with law by passing a speaking order within two months positively from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[5] Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of decision i.e. Annexure CM/1 dated 29.07.2022 accepting the claim of the petitioner as made in the aforementioned representations, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[6] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the application's for placing on record speaking order Annexure CM/1 dated 29.07.2022 as well as permission to withdraw the instant petition are allowed. Accordingly, contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
