By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'anticipatory bail' under the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C., in case FIR No.219, dated 04.09.2019, registered at Police Station City Rajpura, District Patiala, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 420/465/468/471 of the IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in compliance of the order dated 16.06.2022, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurmukh Singh, corroborates the said averment and submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required and even as per the reply dated 03.09.2022, filed in Court today he could not deny the aforesaid averment.
