This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. was filed seeking quashing of FIR No. 135 dated 13.7.2008, under Sections 218, 420, 465, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, 1860 and Sections 12-B of Passport Act and Section 13(2) of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, registered at Police Station City District Moga or in the alternate the prayer was that the Investigating agency be directed to submit the final report.

None has put in appearance on behalf of petitioner *inspite of* two pass-overs.

Learned State counsel has produced order dated 29.9.2020 passed by the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Moga, whereby the untrace report filed with the police was accepted.
