The present petition has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.341, dated 22.9.2020, registered under Sections 307, 506, 34 IPC (Section 326-A IPC added lateron), at Police Station Sadar Fazilka, District Fazilka, wherein the petitioner has been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C.

By virtue of the order dated 14.6.2022, the petitioner was directed to be released on interim bail on his appearance before the trial Court.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that as per the zimni order of the trial Court, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and has been admitted to interim bail. As he is continuously appearing before the trial Court, so the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the same.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, the order dated 14.6.2022 is made absolute. The petitioner will keep on continuously appearing before the trial Court during the trial.

The petition stands allowed.
